**National Network Review (Network 25) Update – Deployment Date**

Further to LTB 033/25 please find attached for your information a letter from Nick Dunn National Distribution Director which communicates the 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025 as the agreed target deployment date for the National Network Review (Network 25).

Further to our discussions, this letter confirms the agreed way forward in relation to the deployment of the National Network Review 2025.

Through our discussions it is recognised that there will be some final areas of adjustment to be concluded and that local and national discussions will continue, in order to finalise duty sets and complete re-picks ahead of the deployment date. It is however essential to move forward with the deployment of the Network Review to ensure we have robust duties in place prior to peak activity.

It is appreciated there have been additional challenges for this review in particular the migration of Large Parcels to Parcelforce and CSS moves into the Mail Centre's, however our continued joint working has ensured these have been incorporated within the activity.

This letter therefore, confirms the target deployment date for the National Network Review 2025 will be Monday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025.

Joint monitoring of the review will continue, and should any issues arise, which could place the agreed deployment date at risk they must be referred to the Network Working Group at the earliest possible opportunity to ensure support and assistance can be provided.

I trust that the above approach allows us to commence deploy the National Network Review on the agreed date of 28<sup>th</sup> July 2025 within VOC's.
