The purpose of this LTB is to highlight to Branches that we are aware a small percentage of members may not have access to a smartphone, tablet, PC or laptop and it is vital that we ensure every member can vote in the ballot.

We ask all Branches to make every effort to make equipment available locally so these members are supported and can vote online. With our extensive representational structure, we are sure this will cover the vast majority of members who will raise issues.

If for some unavoidable reason, Branches are unable to provide this support for members then a provision for the dispatch of a postal return ballot has been put in place. Details of this will be shared with Branches, alongside the facility to request duplicate papers for members who have not received their vote, in the days following the dispatch of the ballot.

To further aid Branches in being able to support members through the process, we will hold a short training and Q&A session on Thursday 31st July at 1pm. Details for the meeting are below:
